## Program at-a-glance

*Bonanza High School, founded in 1976, is a public, urban school in Clark County School District with an enrollment of 2,100 students in grades nine through twelve. The student body and faculty represents a diversity of ethnic and racial backgrounds. The school has 97 certified professional staff members, most with a master's degree. CTE certificate programs are available in the areas of Animation, Business, Furniture/Cabinetry, Graphic Design, Health Science w/EMT, Theater Technology, Video Production, and the state's only Fire Science Academy. A dual enrollment program allows students to earn up to six (6) college credits from the College of Southern Nevada (CSN). Over 400 students are also enrolled in 14 different AP courses in a newly created Advanced Placement Academy.*
