Program at-a-glance

The twelve-time GRAMMY Award-winning Las Vegas Academy of the Arts provides students with a twofold emphasis on academics and the arts. As a FIVE STAR school in the Clark County School District, LVA features an extensive academic curriculum including Dual Credit college courses, CTE courses, Pre-AP and Advanced Placement courses in all core subject areas as well as elective courses. In addition to core classes, each student chooses to pursue one of the following majors: Dance (modern, jazz, ballet, tap, ballroom and choreography); Music (brass, woodwind, percussion, strings, guitar, jazz band, mariachi, voice and piano); Visual Arts (drawing, painting, ceramics, graphic design, animation, visual design, design crafts, photography and video production); and Theatrical Arts (theatre, musical theatre, technical theatre). Extended school day allows for additional classes in each chosen major field to ensure a rigorous, individualized program of study. Community internships, Artist-in-Residence programs and numerous performance opportunities allow LVA students a chance to enhance their skills prior to pursuing their post-secondary plans.
