

Clark County School District Career and Technical Academy Transportation Zone Updates 2025–2026 School Year

Description

With the opening of Clark County School District's (CCSD) newest Career and Technical Academy (CTA), South CTA, the transportation zones for several of the CTAs will change beginning with the 2025–2026 school year. The following schools are impacted by the updated transportation zones:

- South CTA
- Southeast CTA
- Southwest CTA

Required Steps for Parents/Guardians Applying for the 2025–2026 School Year

- Parents/Guardians should verify their student's transportation eligibility for their selected school(s) using the CTA Transportation Boundaries Effective August 2025 map. Please visit <u>magnet.ccsd.net</u> to access the most current map.
- Please remember that parents/guardians are responsible for transportation if students choose to attend a school outside of their transportation zone.

What is the Impact on Current Students at Impacted CTAs?

- Students currently attending the impacted CTAs in Grades 9, 10, and 11 for the 2024–2025 school year will maintain their current transportation eligibility status until they graduate or move out of the transportation zone based on existing transportation boundaries.
- Students who move outside of the existing transportation boundaries and not within the new CTA transportation boundary will not be eligible for service.
- Younger siblings, new to the impacted CTA's, who will attend concurrently with an older sibling who is enrolled at the CTA for the 2024–2025 school year, and reside in the existing transportation zone, will be able to request as-available space on the bus route until the older sibling is no longer at the school or moves outside of the current transportation zone. The older sibling must be an active bus rider in order for the younger sibling to be eligible to request as-available space on the route. As-available transportation service must be requested yearly, and is a privilege subject to a one-day written revocation notice at the discretion of the District.
